### History

Jacob Farrand Pringle (b. 1816) was a lawyer, judge, soldier, author, and a Mayor of Cornwall.

He was born in Valenciennes, France, and moved with his parents to Upper Canada in 1817, settling in Cornwall. He was educated at Cornwall Grammar School and at Osgoode Hall Law School. He was called to the bar in 1838 and returned to Cornwall to practise law. Pringle also served as Clerk of the Peace and County Attorney for the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas, and Glengarry from 1858 to 1866. He was appointed Junior Judge in 1866 and Senior Judge in 1878. He became Surrogate Judge of the Maritime Court of Ontario in 1879, and Local Judge of the High Court in 1882.

Pringle was also active in civic affairs, and served on the town Council of Cornwall from 1852 to 1856. He was mayor of the Town of Cornwall from 1855 to 1856.

In 1837, Pringle joined the voluntary militia as a private. In 1838, he served against the rebel forces in the Rebellion of 1837-38, first as a private, and subsequently as corporal and sergeant. In 1862, he raised the Cornwall Volunteer Infantry Company, and as Captain, commanded them throughout the Fenian disturbances until 1866.

Pringle married Isabella Fraser in 1844, and the couple had ten children.

In 1890, Pringle was the author of Lunenburgh, or the Old Eastern District.

Jacob Pringle's father, James Pringle, was a Lieutenant in the 81st Regiment of Foot in the Napoleonic Wars, who became a half-pay officer after moving to Upper Canada. He married Anne Margaret Anderson, and the couple had three children in addition to Jacob Farrand Pringle: James Dunbar Pringle (b. 1820), Margaret Pringle (b. 1824), and George Pringle (b. 1833).
