Senator and Ex-Minister of Labor Passed Away in His Sleep.

Ottawa. Dec 11. - Hon T.W. Crothers, former Minister of Labor in the Borden Cabinet, and who was appointed to the Senate about two months ago, died suddenly at his home on Carling Avenue, Ottawa, on Saturday evening. Mr. Crothers, who was 71 years of age, had been in poor health for the past year, but not until a couple of weeks ago had his condition given rise to any serious fears. On Saturday he appeared brighter than for some days past and during the afternoon went to his room with the intention of having a rest. When his wife went to call him to meet an old friend who had called at the house, she found that he had died in his sleep.

Senator Crothers was born on the 1st of January, 1850, at Northport, Prince Edward county. He was educated in the public schools and at Albert Colege, Belleville, where he received his degree of B.A. After completing his education Mr. Crothers became headmaster of Wardsville High School. He later studied law and began practice in St. Thomas in 1880.

He was first elected to the House of Commons in 1908, and in 1911 was sworn in as a member of Sir Robert Borden's Cabinet, taking over the portfolio of Labor, which department he administered until his retirement on account of ill-health in 1918. He was appointed to the Senate in succession to the late Hon. W.C. Edwards.

W.G. Crothers Asks For \$40,000 Under Will of Late Hon. W.T. Crothers.

Toronto, April 6 - Wilson G. Crothers, aged 25, son of the late Hon. Thomas W. Crothers, who died in Ottawa on December 10, 1921, today asked Mr. Justice Orde at Osgoode Hall for immediate payment of the \$40,000 legacy left by Mr. Crothers. Judgement was reserved.

According to the will, Wilson G. Crothers, born in St. Thomas but now living in Los Angeles, California, is to receive the annual income from \$40,000 for five years and the principal itself at the end of the period.

Appearing for the son, T.J. Agar, K.C. and T.L. Monahan argued that the legatee was entitled to the corpus as he had attained his majority, even though the testator did provide that five years should elapse,

H.S. White, K.C., for the executrix, the widow, urged that Mr. Crothers must have had a good reason for desiring a delay in the final payment. Mrs. Crothers' affidavit supported this view.

Wilson G. Crothers, in an affidavit, stated: "I am engaged in business in California and it would be of great advantage to me and my nosiness to have the legacy of bequest of \$40,000 paid over to me of securities of the estate to the value of \$40,000 assigned to me."

Mr. Crothers' estate netted about \$85,000.
