The 1784 Provisioning Lists for Disbanded Troops and Loyalists settled in the First Township, Cataraqui show that Michale GRASS had three boys over 10 years, three girls over ten years, and one girll under ten years.

"Captain Michael Grass was born in Strasbourg, Germany. The name is said to have been originally "Kress," the German word for Grass. Were the change instituted by the old Loyalist himself, it must have occurred shortly after his emigration to the Western world; for the name appears under its present form in the power of attorney granted him by George III in 1783. During the hostilities that prevailed between Great Britain and France throughout North America, prior to the American Revolution, Michael Grass rendered loyal service to the British Crown and being captured by the enemy was for some time held as a prisoner of war at the French settlement at Cataraqui. He made his escape and fled to what was then the English province of New York. Soon after Cataraqui was captured by the English under Colonel Bradstreet; the garrison was transported to Montreal, and the French fortress and village of Cataraqui ceased to exist. Its admirable location, however, at the source of the River St. Lawrence, could no longer escape the attention of the British Government and, it was mainly through the instrumentality of Captain Michael Grass, that the important city of Kingston - so intensely loyal to the British Crown - arose upon the ruins of his former place of captivity.

"It is needless to say that Michael Grass served in the Royal ranks during the American Revolution; his sash and sabre with its massive handle of solid silver are still cherished heirlooms among his descendants.

"In 1783 began that remarkable movement in North American history, known as the United Empire Loyalists movement from the United States to Canada. Many of the intrepid patriots sailed from the Atlantic seaboard to New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, and, thence, a considerable number made their way to what is now the Province of Ontario.

"It seemed to the British authorities desirable to direct this movement towards founding a colony at the head waters of the River St. Lawrence; and Michael Grass, on account of his keen intelligence, his proven loyalty, and his familiarity with this part of the country gained during, and prior to, his captivity, was frequently consulted by the general in command and eventually placed at the head of a band of loyalists, who in several ships, and under convoy of a British man-of-war, made their way from New York to Sorel. Hence a detachment under the command of Captain Grass penetrated to Collins Bay. Finding the soil west of the Bay, to be rocky, he is said to have declared that he had come too far to settle upon a rock. However this may be, he picked upon the present township of Kingston, and returned with his companions, for the winter, to Sorel. He assisted in the surveys, running himself the base line for the township of Kingston; and, under the power of attorney issued to him by his Majesty King George III he drew

the lands for the loyalists, their sons and daughters; his own patents embraced one-third of the present city of Kingston.

"He strongly recommended the creation of a separate province to the west of Quebec, and cordially welcomed the establishment of Upper Canada with the seat of government at First Town or Kingston, as it began to be called by the time that Governor Simcoe arrived and began to organize what is now the Province of Ontario.

"Captain Grass bestirred himself to promote the growth and prosperity of the new capital; and the present market, the site of the Court House, and the MacDonald park were presented by him by deed of gift to the city of Kingston, and to this day, worthily perpetuate his memory. He died on April 25th, 1813, having lived to see a flourishing city (of whom he was the foremost citizen) arise upon the ruins of his former place of captivity. That he was not unmindful of the great work that he had accomplished is evidenced by the following extract from a letter written by him two years before his death.

"Seven and twenty years have rolled away since my eyes for the second time beheld the shores of Cataraqui. In that space of time how many changes have taken place. How many of the seats of my associates are now vacant... Yes, seven and twenty years ago scarce the vestige of a human habitation could be found in the whole extent of the Bay of Quinte. Not a settler had dared to penetrate the vast forests that circled its shores. Even on the spot now covered with stately edifices were to be seen only the bark-thatched wigwams of the savage of newly erected tent of the hardy loyalists. That when the ear heard me it blessed me for being strong in my attachment to my sovereign and high in the confidence of my fellow subjects. I led the loyal band; I pointed out to them the site of their future metropolis and gained for persecuted principles, a sanctuary for myself and followers, a home."

"Truly it may be said that Captain Michael Grass was the founder of Kingston; the first citizen of the Bay of Quinte. His descendants are traced in the table annexed. Many of them are scattered, but among them are to be found some of the most substantial and prominent citizens of Ontario, who cherish with commendable pride the traditions of their distinguished ancestry.

"Peter Grass, eldest son of the Pioneer, married Esther, daughter of Major John Everett. She is said to have been the first white child to be born in Kingston. They had several children, their eldest son and child being Robert Everett Grass, who married, first, Nancy Purdy of the old and well-known Purdy family, and second, Mrs. Hagerman, whose maiden name was Gaitrey Ketcheson and whose adventure as a young child lost for eleven days in the forest, has long been a favorite tradition of the Bay district.

"Ruliff Grass, son of Robert Everett Grass and Nancy Purdy his wife, and great-grandson of Captain Michael Grass, was educated at the Stirling High School and at Victoria College. He engaged for some twenty years in mercantile business at Frankford and then became, and still is, largely interested in the dredging business for the Canadian Government. He now resides in Toronto, where he is a leading citizen and recognized as a power in the financial world, being Vice-President of the Excelsior Life Insurance Company, director of the Ontario Bank, etc. Mr. Grass owns the sash and sword worn by his famous ancestor, Captain Michael Grass, and is thoroughly versed in the early history of Ontario.

"Eva Grass, daughter of the Pioneer, married Peter Wartman. The Wartmans, together with the Days, the Herchemers, the Purdys, the Everetts, and the Grasses, are reckoned among the very first of the United Empire Loyalists. Peter Wartman drew lands upon the Lake Shore, and the Royal patent confirming his title is now in the possession of his grandson, Henry Richardson. His possession, however, had long antedated the receipt of this document; indeed, the Wartman family have held lands granted by the Crown since 1784; lands, that at no time during these one hundred and twenty years, have been incumberered (sic) for a single dollar.

"Peter Wartman, son of Henry Wartman, married Hester Burdett Day. They had eight children; their daughter, Susanna, became the wife of James Richardson, a leading citizen of Kingston, whose large business since his decease, is carried on by his sons, George and Henry.

"Another very distinguished representative and descendant of Captain Michael Grass, is E.J.B. Pense, M.L.A., editor and proprietor of the British Whig, Kingston. He is equally prominent in the political, newspaper and business world, and enjoys, withal, a high degree of well-merited popularity."

"Captain Michael Grass, the first settler of Kingston township, was a native of Germany. The period of his emigration to America is unknown. He was a saddler and harness-maker by trade, and for years plied his trade in Philadelphia. It would seem that he removed from Philadelphia to New York, for his son Peter was born in this city in 1770. According to the statement of his grandson who often heard the facts from his father, Peter Grass, soon after the commencement of the rebellion, Michael Grass was taken prisoner by the Indians, who were staying at Cataraqui. In this he is probably mistaken. We learn from another source that it was during the previous French war, which is more likely to be correct. It would seem that Grass and two other prisoners were not confined in the fort, but held in durance by a tribe of Indians, who permitted them to hunt, fish, &c. They made an effort to escape, but were caught and brought back. Again they attempted, carrying with them provisions, which they had managed to collect, sufficient to last them a week. But it was nine weeks before they reached an English settlement, one having died by the way from hunger and exposure. It was the knowledge which Grass had acquired of the territory at Cataraqui, while a prisoner, which led to his appointment to the leadership of a band of refugees at the close of the war.

"It does not appear that Captain Grass occupied any office in the army during the war. His captaincy commenced upon his leaving New York with the seven vessels for Canada. By virtue of his captaincy, he was entitled to draw 3000 acres. Beside lot twenty-five in Kingston, he drew in fourth concession of Sidney nearly 2000 acres in one block.

"Captain Grass had three sons, Peter, John, and Daniel, and three daughters. Daniel, some years after, went sailing and was never heard from. Peter and John settled in the Second Town and became the fathers respectively of families. The land drawn by the captain, and the 600 acres by each of his children, has proved a lasting source of wealth and comfort to his descendants.

"Captain Grass naturally took a leading part at least during the first years of the settlement at Kingston. He was possessed of some education, and was a man of excellent character, with a strict sense of honor. Although opportunities presented themselves to accumulate property at the expense of others, he refused to avail himself of all such. He was appointed a magistrate at an early period, and as such performed many of the first marriages in Kingston. In religion, he was an adherent to the Church of England. Probably he had been brought up a Lutheran. His old "Dutch" Bible still is read by an old German in Ernesttown; but it seems a pity that although none of the Grass family can read its time worn pages, it should be allowed to remain in other hands than the descendants of the old captain.

"In connection, it may be mentioned that some time before the war, a poor German, a baker by trade, came to New York. Michael Grass assisted him into business, and even gave him a suit of clothes. When the refugees came to Canada, this baker accompanied them. He settled in Quebec, where he amassed eventually great wealth, and the P-family are not unknown to the public."

He was a Captain in the New York Militia, the members of which were ranked as Associated Loyalists. As such hewas declared by the Executive Council at Quebec, on August 15, 1791,to be entitled to 1,750 acres of land. In Bishop Richardson's Recollections, already quoted from, he is credited with having been a prisoner of war at Fort Frontenac before it was taken from the French and with having been able therefore to give Sir Guy Carleton information asto the suitability of Upper Canada as a place of settlement for the Loyalists leaving New York in 1783. The Bishop derived his information, he said, from Capt. Grass' son, John, who was a fellow-Methodist, living in the Township of Kingston, near Collins' Bay.

Mr. Grass was a native of Germany and had, like many of his compatriots, emigrated to the Province of New York. On the outbreak of the rebellion, he was living on a farm about thirty miles from the city of New York. Though offered a Captain's omission by the rebel general, he remained firm in his allegiance to King George III.

Acceding to Sir Guy Carleton's request, he went with the Loyalists as their guide to Upper Canada. They wintered at Sorel and proceeded on their journey in the spring, arriving duly at Fort Frontenac and pitching their tents "on Indian Point, where the marine docks at Kingston now stand." "Here they awaited the survey of the townships, which was not accomplished so as to have the lots ready for location before July."

To Capt. Grass the Governor, who is said to have been present at the allotment, allowed the first choice for his company. He took the township of Kingston, Sir John Johnson Ernesttown, Col. Rogers, Fredericksburg, Major Vanalstine Adolphustown, and Col. McDonell Marysburg for theirs respectively. Capt. Grass desiring turnip seed, as that would yield a crop though sown so late, it was supplied to him. "Each man, taking a handful, cleared a spot of ground about the centre of what is now the town of Kingston, sowed the seed, and raised a fine crop of turnips, which partly served for their need during the ensuing winter."

The Captain's own piece of land was a triangle adjoining the town on the southwest. It extended in a northwesterly direction from Murney's Point, "then called and known for many years as Grass' Point." By students of the old plan of Kingston it will be recognized as Macdonald Park.

"He was respected by all who knew him for the honesty and integrity of his character. He was somewhat hasty and irritable in temper, but was always to be relied upon as a friend and neighbour. In his old age he, like most aged people, loved to recite in minute detail the adventures of his youth. He lived to a very advanced age and died a victim of cancer." His story-telling was not always appreciated by the younger generation, especially when there was statute labour to be done, as witness the Kingston Gazette of December 17, 1811.

Grass St., as Wellington St. was named on the plan of the original city, commemorated the founder of Kingston, as he may with reason be called. It is regrettable that remembrance of him was at a later time blotted out, for every community does well to remember the pioneers.

GRASS, MICHAEL, office holder; b. c. 1735 in Strasbourg, France; m. first Mary Ann – ; m. secondly Margaret Swartz, and they had at least six children; d. 25 April 1813 in Kingston, Upper Canada.

Michael Grass was part of the considerable emigration of Palatinate Germans to North America in the 18th century. He arrived on 22 Sept. 1752 at Philadelphia, Pa, where he remained for a while, earning his living as a saddler. He subsequently moved to Tryon County, N.Y., where lie operated a saddlery in addition to farming and thereby achieved a modest prosperity. A captain in the local militia, he refused to join the rebels after the outbreak of the American revolution. In 1777 he fled to New York City where he served as a lieutenant in the volunteer militia.

Grass's historical reputation derives from his connection with the settlement of loyalists at Cataraqui (Kingston, Ont.) after the revolution. Family tradition and popular lore accord him the position of founder. These accounts maintain that he had been a prisoner at the old French Fort Frontenac (Cataraqui) during the Seven Years' War, and thus, towards the end of the revolution, when the British commandant at New York City, Sir Guy Carleton, asked him about the area he was in a position to recommend it. Grass may have had some familiarity with Cataraqui; there is, however, no evidence to corroborate this version of the settlement's founding.

A more plausible account is as follows. On 26 May 1783 Governor Haldimand ordered Surveyor General Samuel Johannes Holland to Cataraqui to consider "the facility of establishing a settlement" there. Two months later, Major John Ross* was ordered to prepare the site for a military post. In the mean time, numbers of loyalist refugees, including Grass, were awaiting evacuation from New York City to Nova Scotia; on 12 June Grass had written on behalf of a group of them that "we cannot think of going to another place in the Universe for the many Benefits that will flow from that Settlement [Cataraqui] to the Settler." On 2 July he was given a temporary commission of captain for the second of the eight companies organized for transportation to Quebec. This group, many of whom were Associated Loyalists, probably numbered fewer than 500. Grass's transport Camel was the first of nine to reach Quebec, arriving there on 12 August. Three days later, Haldimand's military secretary, Robert Mathews, indicated to Ross the governor's intention to settle many of the New York exiles in the neighbourhood of Cataraqui. The actual decision, however, was not made until Haldimand had received reports indicating the suitability of the area for farming. In early September, while most of the New York loyalists prepared to winter at Sorel, Grass and 37 men ascended the St Lawrence River with a survey party to mark out the settlements at Cataraqui. When he returned to Sorel in late fall he found there another company from New York led by Major Peter Van Alstine. The presence of a new group led to jealousy and factionalism; Grass and several other captains complained of persons who "Presume to Place themselves at our head without our consent or Approbation."

In January 1784 Grass and others petitioned Haldimand for large-scale assistance in setting up their farms. They also indicated their preference for a "Form of Government . . . similar to that which they Enjoyed in the Province of New York in the year of 1763." Haldimand informed them that their requests were impossible to meet and reminded them that if they were not happy with his plans he could provide them passage to Nova Scotia. Several months later the governor was angered by Grass's seeming claim on behalf of himself and his "party" that they had "first found out and planned the settlement." Grass demurred, however, reportedly claiming "he only ment that he was the first of the Loyalists who before they left New York pointed out that [Cataraqui] as the most desirable place to go to" After a winter of discontent, the loyalists began the trek to their new home on 24 May 1784. The settlement from the Bay of Quinte to Cataraqui was divided into numbered townships; Grass's party of some 220 was granted Township No.1 (Cataraqui).

Grass's leadership in the new community was short-lived. He was appointed a justice of the peace for the Montreal District (which then included the new loyalist townships) on 18 April 1785. In this capacity, he signed a petition for English land tenure, local courts, and municipal government, as well as for more schools and clergymen. However, when in 1788 Carleton (now Lord Dorchester) established four new administrative districts in western Quebec to meet loyalist needs, Grass was not appointed to any of the new civil offices. After this period his contribution to local society was limited; he was, for instance, a benefactor of the local Church of England congregation and served as vestryman in 1789.

The legend of Michael Grass, founder of Cataraqui, cannot be sustained by the evidence. But there remains, to his credit, an image of a determined, possibly even imaginative, leader who resisted the normal direction of refugee

emigration from New York City and helped not only to influence, but to push to conclusion, the decision to settle the wilderness later known as Ontario. Perhaps he is best remembered for a letter that he wrote to the Kingston Gazette in 1811, harking back to the days when, "strong in my attachment to my sovereign, and high in the confidence of my fellow subjects, I led the loyal band, I pointed out to them the scite of their future metropolis, and gained for persecuted principles a sanctuary[,] for myself and followers a home."

NOTES ON EARLY SETTLEMENTS.

The following narrative relates to some of the pioneers of Upper Canada, who settled in the townships of Kingston, Ernesttown, Fredericksburg, Adolphustown and Marysburg, at the entrance of the Bay of Quinté. I had it a few years ago from John Grass, an old and well-known inhabitant of the Township of Kingston, near Collins Bay.

He was 11 years old when his father settled there. His statement was as follows (as near as I can recollect) my father, Michael Grass lived, at the breaking out of the Revolutionary War, on a farm about 30 miles above New York. He was a native of Germany but had lived most of his time in America. When the Revolution commenced, General Herkimer sent my father an invitation to join the Americans and offered him a Captain's Commission. My father replied—" I have sworn allegiance to one king and I cannot serve any other". For this saying he was driven from his house and family and was obliged to take refuge within the British lines at New York. His family followed shortly afterwards. He lost his farm and property, and was obliged to maintain his family at New York by working as a harness maker. At the close of the war the British General commanding at New York, having heard that my father had been a prisoner of time of the old French war, sent for him to enquire about the place and said—Mr. the French at Frontenac, in the Grass, I understand that you have been at Frontenac in Canada. What sort of a country is it? Can people live there?" My father replied—"What I saw of it I think it a fine country, and if people were settled there I think they would do very well". The Governor replied—"Oh, Mr. Grass, I am delighted to hear you say so, for we don't know what to do with the poor loyalists, the city is full to them and we cannot send them all to Nova Scotia. Would you be willing, Mr. Grass, to take charge of such as would be willing to go with you to Frontenac? If so, I can furnish you a conveyance by ship to Quebec, and rations for you all till such time as you have means to provide for yourselves".

My father asked for three days in which to make up his mind. At the end of the three days he accepted. Notices were then posted throughout the city, calling upon all those who would go to Frontenac to enrol their names with Mr. Grass. The company of men, women and children having been completed, a ship was provided and furnished, and they started for the unknown and distant region, leaving behind them homes and friends of their youth, never, probably to see them again; the fruits of all their former toils and sufferings being thus sacrificed on the altar of their loyalty. The first season they got no further than Sorel in Lower Canada where they were obliged to erect log huts for shelter during the winter.

The next spring they took boats and proceeding up the St. Lawrence, at last reached Frontenac and pitched their tents on Indian Point, where the Marine Docks of Kingston now stand. Here they awaited the survey of the townships, which was not accomplished so as to have the lots ready for location before July. In the meantime several other companies had arrived under their respective leaders, some of which had come across the country by way of Lake Champlain. In the meantime the Governor, who had removed to Quebec, paid them a visit, and riding along the lake shore on a fine day, exclaimed to my father—"Why, Mr. Grass, you have indeed a fine country, and I am really glad to find it so". While the several companies were waiting for the completion of the survey, some would say to my father -"The Governor will not give you the first choice to the land but will prefer Sir John Johnson, with his company because he is a great man". But my father declared he did not believe that, and if the Governor did so he would feel

injured and leave. At length the time came in July, for the townships to be given out, and the Governor assembling the leaders around him, called for Mr. Grass, and said -"Now you were the first person to mention this fine country and have been here formerly as a prisoner of war, you must have the first choice. The townships are numbered 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th; which do you choose for your company?" My father says -"The 1st". (Kingston). Then the Governor said to Sir John Johnson - "Which do you choose?" "The 2nd" (Ernesttown) was the reply. Colonel Rogers took the 3rd (Fredericksburg), Major Vanalston the 4th (Adolphustown), and Colonel Macdonell the 5th (Marysburgh).

So the first settlement of Loyalist immigrants was formed in Upper Canada.

"His daughter Gatrey is the subject of a well-known incident that happened when she was a child five years old. The family was living in the fifth concession of Sidney, and the child was sent on an errand to the house of a neighbour, Duncan Irvine, some miles distant. The forest intervened, and when darkness approached and she had not returned, the parents became alarmed. As it was evident that Gatrey had wandered from the trail and was lost, the two families instituted a search. Several Indian scouts and hunters were engaged, and for miles around the woods were searched; but the night was dark, and, to add to the difficulty, a storm of rain and hail set in. On Monday every settler and brave in the neighborhood turned out to assist; on Tuesday, the searchers had increased to three hundred. They shouted, fired guns, and looked in every hole and brush heap; caves of bears and other wild animals were searched. On Friday, Indian runners were sent up and down the Bay to call for help to find the body, as it was supposed by then that the child must be dead. The force increased to five hundred. They organized into squads and scoured the forest in every direction, but their efforts were unavailing until, just as they were about to abandon the search, the child was found alive. The joyful news was proclaimed by shouts that made the forest ring with the glad acclaim. Gatrey had wandered eight days in the forest, and had subsisted on wintergreens. The nights were cold and she was barefooted and thinly clad. One night an animal of some kind lay upon her cold feet, and lest it might kill her, she was afraid to stir. Just before she was found, she had lain down to die, having previously repeated a verse she had learned of her prayers. She was reduced to a skeleton, and it was some time before she recovered from the terrible experience. For months she shrank with terror at the approach of darkness; but in time the baneful effects of her eight day's exposure to October weather in a Canadian forest passed away, and she grew into strong and vigorous womanhood."
