1841: Widowed, lived with children Frederica, Eliza, James, Henry and Charles on London Road, Village of Wotton, St. Mary de Lode, Gloucestershire. Martha JAMES, 22 was a servant to the family.

1861: Sarah was widowed and living with her children at Dacre Hill, Rock Ferry, Higher Bebington, Cheshire. The family had a house servant, Elizabeth LUST, married, 40, born Somersetshire.

1871: Lived with daughter Eliza and servant Elizabeth LUST in Dacre Hill, Rock Ferry.

1884: Estate of GBP 4554/1/11 probated to Eliza Ellen KEMP, spinster and daughter, the sole Executrix.

1841: Not living with widowed mother and family in Gloucester... had he sailed for Jamaica by then?

1857 - 1858: Flynn's Directory for Kingston has no mention of the family, so it would appear that they arrived in Kingston (Ontario) prior to 1861.

1861: Family enumerated in Victoria Ward, Kingston. Lived in a frame house with a small garden. Wife's sister Janet lived with the family.

1865: Mitchell's Kingston Directory lists George J. Kemp, an accountant and commission agent, with offices at Princess near Wellington, and a residence at the "head of Earl" street in Kingston.

1871: Age shown as 50 (born c. 1821 in England.) Family lived in Cataraqui Ward, Kingston. Janet M. MCTAGGART, 45, born Jamaica lived with the family.

1873: Family lived on Wellington Street, Kingston

1881: Family lived in Kingston, Frontenac County, Ontario.

1885: Irwin's Kingston City Directory shows residence at 104 Clergy Street, Kingston. That building (Barnstaple Terrace) still exists (west side of Clergy between Brock and Princess Streets).

By 1889 the family had moved from 104 Clergy Street to 44 Clergy Street. (Irwin's Kingston Directory)

1890: Probate record shows death date as 18 JAN 1890, Estate resworn to GBP 973/15/7 in England, probated London, 29 SEP 1891 to Mary Jane KEMP, Widow.

At death of daughter Mary in Kingston in 1933, the informant, Marsden Aston KEMP shows a birthplace of "England."

1930: Son Joseph in Rochester shows his mother's birthplace as "New York."

1890: Widowed Mary lived at 264 Brock Street, Kingston.

1893 - 1898: Mary and son Marsden lived at 380 Alfred Street, Kingston

1901: Widowed, lived at 93 Queen Street, Rideau Ward, Kingston with four children, sister Janet MCTAGGART and granddaughter Violet MCNIECE. (That building has been replaced by a Staples Store.)

1903: Mary and daughter Mary lived at 93 Queen... Marsden was not living with the family, but he was back at 93 Queen by 1908.
