1918-1920: Studied at Harvard; earned Master's Degree in Silviculture 1920: Earned Master's degree in Biology, McMaster University. September 1920: Began 42-year career with Ontario Department of Lands and Forests. 1935: Permanent secretary of Canadian Society of Forest Engineers (CFSE), publication "The Forestry Chronicle".

Became known as "Mr. Conservation"

Sayings of Samuel Woodstock (S.W), fictitious character and alias used by A.H. Richardson:

"River valley development is the wise use of all the natural resources of a river valley for all the people... for all time."

"I am convinced that these swamps, bogs and marshes were ordained in the beginning in the divine order of things to be left as natural reservoirs, and much heart-searching and thought should be exercised before they are discarded for some other use."

"As I contemplate the teaming thousands who will come to our fair province in the years that lie ahead, and realize the paucity of open spaces for their healthful recreation, I fear that we who call ourselves conservationists today will be grouped with the great Socrates, whose name are now forgotten but are remembered for their dullness of apprehension."

"Conservation with its abundance of good things is rooted in the future."
